### SECTION 7. FIELDS AND ETIQUETTE (Printed from the CSL Rules and Regulations)

- A. All clubs/teams or co-op groups (see B below) must submit a current year **Field Parameters** application detailing field information. The scheduler shall strive for the maximum use of each field on a home-and-away basis, with consideration given to referee availability.
- The field should be available on both Saturday and Sunday to start play at 8:30 AM and end play at dusk. (10 PM if lighted)
  - The field should be available on both Saturday and Sunday and the weekend after Labor Day in September through the end of January.
  - Based on full day of playing time (9 hours), you can have up to nine teams assigned per field. Additional fields will require a **Field Parameters** application.
  - You must have a minimum of six (6) teams assigned to a field to accommodate referees. Co-op groups will be organized to meet this requirement.
  - The field must be deemed "safe" as reviewed by a CSL Committee or designate and approved by the CSL BOD.
  - The field must have the appropriate permit issued by the local authority, a copy of the permit should be submitted with the Field Parameters application or prior to the start of season.
  - The field must have appropriate additional named insurance as required by local authority and provided by CYSA-South. Please contact CYSA-S for the insurance application.
  - Field Parameters** applications not meeting any of the listed requirements must be approved by the CSL BOD before teams are accepted for bracketing.
- B. A co-op group will be organized for independent teams to play on "common fields" whenever possible. CSL cannot accommodate independent teams without their cooperative help.
- C. The term "home field" may represent a field closest to the area of the home team rather than the team's own field. Use of "common fields" is necessary for assignment of referees for complete coverage of games. The CSL BOD must obtain permission from the permitted soccer club to use a field as a "common field".
- D. The first home team shall be responsible for the condition of the field of play, the proper field marking, and proper equipment i.e., goal posts, nets and corner flags. It shall be the responsibility of each team to have a game ball. (CYSA-S 2.6)

I understand the need to have the fields permitted, insured and maintained to the highest level of grooming and safety as possible. I further understand that field changes of schedule games (unless Act of God) will be assessed \$50.00 for each day of competition. Enclosed is the necessary permits and insurance rider, or a detailed letter stating who will be issuing the permit and when and/or any other information necessary to allow CSL to qualify this application for acceptance.
