About League Cup

- CSL League Cup is a tournament organized by Coast Soccer League.
- League Cup is played near the end of the Regular League Season and is offered to any CSL Team in good standing that has participated in the current regular season.
- There is no additional cost to play in League Cup other than Ref Fees
- Teams in any Age Group wishing to participate in League Cup are seeded against other teams in that Age Group based upon their approximate position in the standings on Oct 1st.
- CSL Rules and Regulations Section 19 - Competitions, Standings and Awards. The tournament is played starting with one or two preliminary rounds, and then goes to an elimination format. The games are played on CSL venues throughout the CSL area.
- The preliminary round(s) are scheduled on a Saturday/Sunday, when teams have League byes.
- Pools of three teams play two games each. The winners of each pool, and possibly a few second-place teams as Wild Cards, will advance to the next round.

About League Cup

- If a second round of pool play is needed those new pool winners will then advance to the elimination rounds
- After that, it is just a matter of eliminating teams until there are only two left.
- The winner of the League Cup Final is the new League Cup Champion for that season, and the losing team becomes the League Cup Finalist.
- Players on both teams are awarded a trophy and an appropriate t-shirt. The coach of the Champion Team is awarded a large Cup Trophy.
- There is no fee to play in League Cup. Any team that has participated in the current Regular Season is qualified to play.
- **Each Team Manager MUST sign-up if their team wants to participate. To sign-up your team go to the CSL App, and go to “Team Manager - Edit Team”**

About League Cup

- **League Cup Rules are under Section 19 of CSL 2022 Rules and Regulations**
- **Game Times:**
 - 2015 through 2010 = 50 minutes
 - 2009 and 2008 = 60 minutes
 - 2007 through 2003 = 70 minutes
- Roster are frozen on the Friday night before the first scheduled game of the age group.
- Pools may consist of three (3) teams and play each other on one (1) day. Pool games may end in ties.
- Other rules for League Cup, such as Tiebreakers for games can be found in CSL Rules.

 - First Round will play October 23, Second Round Nov 6 with Elimination Rounds Dec. 3rd, 4th, 10th
- **2011 - 2012 Teams:**
 - First Round will play Oct. 16, Second Round Oct 30 and Nov 12 with Elimination Rounds Nov. 19, Dec. 3rd, 4th
- **2009 - 2010 Teams:**
 - First Round will play Oct. 23, Second Round Nov. 13, with Elimination Rounds Nov. 20th, Dec. 3rd, 4th, 10th
- **2008 Teams:**
 - First Round will play Oct. 15, Second Round October 22, with Elimination Rounds Oct. 30, Nov. 6, 19, 20th
- **2007 Teams:**
 - First Round will play October 16, Second Round October 29, with Elimination Rounds Nov. 6, 19, 20th
- **2003 - 2006 Teams:**
 - First Round will play October 23, Second Round/Elimination Round Oct. 30, Nov. 6, 13th
