As the majority of the Boys enter their senior year of high school, we reflect on the remarkable accomplishments of these young men over the past four years, without overlooking the hard work they've been putting in since 2018, when most of the players in this group first came together. From 2022 to 2024, the Boys have competed in three consecutive National Cup Finals, winning the U-15 title and most recently the U-17 title this past spring. They also won the California Regional League in 2023 as U-16s and represented Calsouth at the FarWest Regionals in 2022 and 2023, reaching the semifinals both times. Unfortunately, the team could not travel to Hawaii for the 2024 tournament due to the high costs.

In December 2023, they competed in the National League Conference Playoffs at the ESPN Complex in Orlando, where they won all three of their matches against highly rated teams from New Jersey, Ohio, and Wisconsin. In these games, the Boys displayed remarkable resilience, coming back from a 3-0 deficit to beat the Croatian Eagles (Wisconsin) 6-5 and from 2-0 down to beat FC Spire (Ohio) 3-2. Their determination in these comeback victories was truly inspiring. As bracket champions in Orlando, the Boys advanced to the National PRO Championship round in Oceanside last May, where they played for a spot in the 2024 National Finals in Orlando. They lost in a heart-wrenching penalty shootout to the Indiana Hoosiers after leading 2-1 with just 8 minutes remaining before conceding the tying goal.

While this was a difficult loss, it has only fueled the Boys' determination as they head into their final year as club and high school players. They are all working hard to pursue their goals in both soccer and academics, with many aspiring to play college or professional soccer. They fully understand the dedication, commitment, and sacrifices required to achieve their dreams. Coaches, parents, siblings, and friends are immensely proud of all the Boys have accomplished and will continue to support them every step of the way. We will also forever cherish the memory of our beloved Ayden Gomez, who remains a part of the team and continues to cheer on the Boys from above.
