

# WHY WE LOVE REFEREES

**WE HEAR A LOT ABOUT RESPECT IN SOCCER. THE WORD ITSELF MEANS “TO SHOW CONSIDERATION FOR; TREAT COURTEOUSLY OR KINDLY.”**

Its root goes even deeper—“to look back or often at one.” When I searched the Laws of the Game, I found the word respect mentioned more than twenty times.

From Law 5 – The Referee: “The decisions of the referee, and all other match officials, must always be respected.” This caught my attention. Respect isn’t just a rule for referees—it’s a principle for the entire soccer community. Just as referees deserve respect, referees should also respect players, coaches, managers, and spectators. For soccer to thrive, respect must be mutual, not merely mandated.

Ask yourself: How would I want to be treated if I were the coach, player, spectator, or referee?

## RESPECT THE GAME

- As a soccer coach or parent, you shape the atmosphere at games—not just for your child, but for everyone involved.
- Together, we can improve the match environment by encouraging respect throughout the soccer community.

“Football is a game of mistakes.”

As Johan Cruyff, the legendary Dutch player, once said. Players miss open goals, defenders sometimes score own goals, and referees miss calls. None of it is intentional.

The game is fast, decisions are complex, and errors are inevitable. Referees often recognize when they’ve missed something and wish they could take it back. Just like players, referees must learn, move on, and get back in the game.

The toughest calls involve handballs, fouls, and offside.



Many players and parents misunderstand offside altogether. (Hint: it's not where the ball is received!) That's why I encourage anyone interested to review the laws, or better yet, take a course and become a referee.

## WHAT REALLY MATTERS

When I think back on my children's soccer years, I don't remember the scores, wins, losses, trophies or championships. I do remember family time, friendships, and the joy of watching them grow. That is what lasts, that is what really matters.

Every referee, just like every player, is on a journey. Most want nothing more than to keep the game safe, fair, and enjoyable. It's a challenging task, but with your support and understanding, referees can improve every week. As Abraham Lincoln wisely put it: "I don't like that man. I must get to know him better."

So why do people choose to referee?

- For love of the game.
- To give back to the sport.
- To stay active.
- To earn money while doing something meaningful.

Referees develop in the same way that players develop. They start doing games, they make mistakes, they learn from their mistakes, and they improve. Their education includes:

- 1) Learning the Laws of the Game
- 2) Applying those laws within the Spirit of the Game
- 3) Managing the emotions of a youth match—players, coaches, and spectators alike

Game management is the hardest skill of all, often taking years of experience. Every year, referees must re-certify. This involves:

- Attending 5 hours of instruction
- Completing an online Law Review
- Passing a 50-question test
- Meeting practical training requirements

Higher-level referees must also complete additional training, fitness tests, and match evaluations. Referee Coaches and Mentors guide them along the way.

### A Referee's Responsibility

- Protect player safety
- Interfere as little as possible
- Penalize only deliberate infractions

Constant whistling for trifling fouls ruins the flow of play and frustrates everyone. Referees are trained to "wait and see"—to give players the chance to continue if there's an advantage.

## SETTING THE RIGHT EXAMPLE

I once overheard an 11-year-old substitute say: "Ref, you obviously have no idea what you are doing." Words like these don't come out of nowhere—they're learned by watching adults. At younger levels, parents can be the biggest challenge for referees. As players reach U12, coaches can push boundaries. By U14, players begin imitating the negative behavior they've seen.

We often hear that referees need "thick skin." I disagree; this implies they no longer care. Most referees care deeply. Being called "terrible" or "horrible" hurts. And we must ask ourselves: What are we teaching our children when we speak to others that way? Isn't there enough hate in this world, do we really want to introduce this type of behavior to 8, 9, 10, 11, 12... year olds? As one referee once said: "I wish you could be a referee for one day, so you know how much we care."

## BE THE CHANGE

So, before every match, ask yourself: What really matters? If you find yourself frustrated with refereeing, don't just complain—become a referee. Be the change you want to see. When parents, coaches, players, and referees work together, the game becomes:

- Safer
- Fairer
- And more enjoyable for everyone

And isn't that what we all want?



## LA POWER FC





Heading into their eighth and final season, Central Coast Surf B08 Elite knows exactly what they're about: commitment. To the game. To each other. To constantly improving.






